Horse Show Rules

1. Helmets must be worn at all times while mounted.
2. Unjudged warm up rounds will \$10, and available as posted.
3. Entry fees will be \$20 per class.
4. Payment may be made with cash or check payable to Friendship Field Farm. Credit cards not accepted.
5. **Pre-entries close the Wednesday before each show (5/19, 6/16, 7/28, 8/25, 9/8).** Post entries will be accepted, with a one time post entry fee of \$20 per entry. There will be no charge for entering additional classes the day of the show. **Each entry must be signed, and include payment or a signed blank check.**
6. Returned checks are subject to a \$30 fee.
7. Classes may be cancelled, split or combined as entries warrant.
8. Food will be sold on the show grounds.
9. EMT will be on show grounds.
10. There will not be a farrier available, so please plan accordingly.
11. Please be respectful of the show grounds and clean up after yourselves and your horses.
12. Year End High Score Awards will be given at last show of the season. Must show in at least three shows to be eligible for end of season high score awards. *Eligible divisions are denoted with an asterisk on Class Description page.*
13. **Please refer to additional COVID-19 protocols below.**

We are grateful to have the opportunity to run our Seacoast Horse Show Series again this season. That said, in order to be able to safely do so, we will need everyone's help and cooperation. We have established the following protocols with consideration to state, federal and WHO guidelines and recommendations, and expect everyone to adhere to them. COVID-19 Horse Show Protocols

- One rider/trainer at the in-gate at a time.
- Additional holding areas are in place to avoid crowding near in-gates. Horses/riders are to remain in holding area until called up to in-gate.
 - Ring 1 - Far side of arena & lower grass area if needed
 - Ring 2 - Area marked off adjacent to office
- Back to back jumping rounds are encouraged.
- Show Office
 - Use side windows
 - No one inside (except staff)
 - **Pre entries strongly encouraged**
 - Trainer Packets with all necessary forms, numbers, strings, etc... will be available in the morning for pick up outside of the office
 - Adds/Scratches should be texted to Kara at 603-831-2759
- Ribbons
 - Ribbons will not be presented in the rings. Ribbons will be available upon completion of each division, and will be distributed at designated awards table(s).
- Hand washing stations and hand sanitizer will be available on show grounds.
- Please practice social distancing throughout the show grounds. Masks are required where social distancing is not possible, but may be removed when riding.
